**Comments**

Prices were mixed at today's sale. Poorer styled crossbred fleece still struggling to find a level. A good offering of Merino wool saw exporters being selective on their purchases. Mid micron types were cheaper with selected micron categories in the 21 to 25 micron sought after. Chinese crossbred hogget types were mixed with the finer crossbred types mostly affected.
