**Comments**

Prices were mixed at today's sale. Finer crossbred types were erratic with exporters selective on their purchases. Coarse crossbred fleece showing discolouration showed limited competition. Second shear types on a limited offering were firm. Merino prices continued to be in good demand as was the small amount of mid micron types. The high passing rate was due to growers reserving wool.
