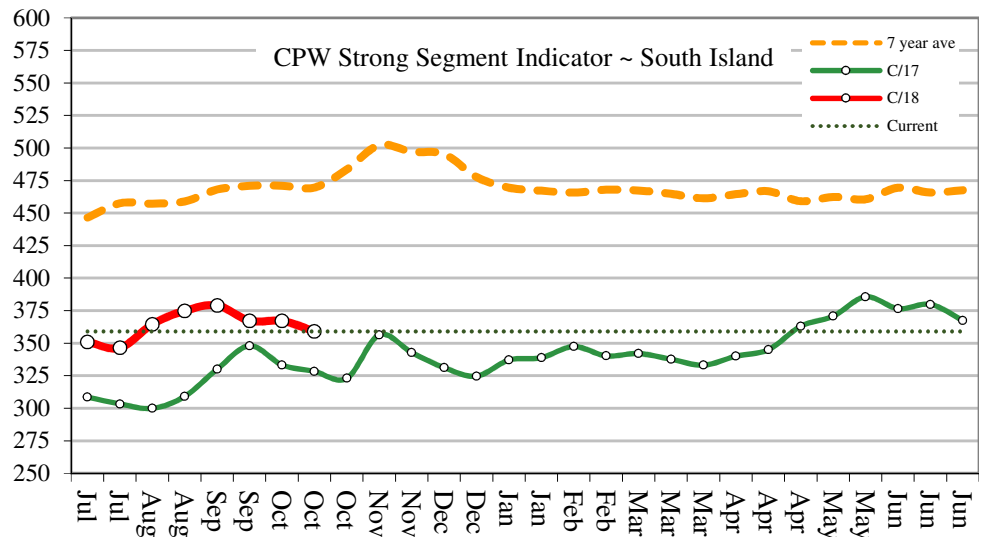
Wool prices declined across all categories at today's South Island Wool sale. 27 micron and finer were the most affected with prices up to \$1.00 clean cheaper. Merino prices also suffered the same decline with some finer micron lots up to \$3.00 clean cheaper. Crossbred hogget types were irregular but did meet with some strong competition for the finer types. Crossbred second shear saw competition well spread. The Australian wool market has plummeted in recent weeks, coming off record highs. Chinese business continues to be slow, and this has been reflected in our market.
